- Increase the percentage of **Year Three** students in NAPLAN upper two bands (**U2B**) to **30%** or above in **reading** in 2020
- Increase the percentage of **Year Three** and **Year Five** students achieving NAPLAN national minimum standard (**NMS**) to **95%** in **reading** in 2020

Our initiatives include

- Targeting specific groups of students through participation in online intervention programs to improve reading outcomes.
- Improving the consistency, capability and collaboration of teachers and teacher aides to effectively support and lift student performance in reading through **differentiated reading blocks**
- Consolidate teacher capability to successfully analyse student data on a short cycle basis in order to inform successful, timely, data-driven actions in response to individual student needs
- Implementing a whole school collegial engagement strategy for pedagogical improvement through observation, reflective conversation, coaching and feedback


